THE BEGINNINGS OF GUARDIAN ANGEL CATHEDRAL

Guardian Angel Cathedral is unique not only for its magnificent windows, mosaics, murals, and architectural design but also for its origin and history.

Its beginnings go back to 1958, when the Clerics of St. Viator began celebrating a 4:30 AM Sunday Mass at various hotels on the Strip to accommodate hotel/casino workers and visitors. The present church became a reality in 1963 as the "Guardian Angel Shrine." When the Diocese of Reno became the Diocese of Reno-Las Vegas in 1977, the Shrine was designated as the Co-Cathedral of the Catholic Church in Nevada.

In 1995, the Diocese of Las Vegas was established with Guardian Angel Cathedral as the Cathedral of the Diocese of Las Vegas. In 1988, Guardian Angel Cathedral received an Indult, a special permission, from Rome for the 2:30 PM Saturday Mass to be recognized as a vigil Mass. Because ninety percent of the participants in our Eucharistic celebrations are visitors from all over the world, this Mass is a great help in caring for those who wish to fulfill their Sunday obligation. In May 2023, Pope Francis elevated the Diocese of Las Vegas to the Archdiocese of Las Vegas, naming Archbishop George Leo Thomas, Ph.D., its first archbishop.

To our local parishioners and volunteers, we sincerely thank you for your devoted and dedicated service to the people of God at Guardian Angel Cathedral.

A LETTER FROM THE ARCHBISHOP

My Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

The annual second collection for Seminary and Clergy Education and Development takes place on the weekend of July 20 and 21. This collection helps offset the high costs of tuition, housing, and the education of our Seminarians. It also supplements the ongoing education of our priests.

Our Seminarians are studying at Mount Angel Seminary in Oregon, St. Mary of the Lake Seminary in Mundelein, Illinois, and St. John's Seminary in Camarillo, California.

This past May, I had the distinct honor to ordain our two newest Priests, Father "AJ" Sales and Father Michael Williams. As our new Archdiocese continues to grow, we are thankful for all our Priests and Seminarians, and those discerning the call to Priesthood in the Archdiocese of Las Vegas.

This summer, the Seminarians are engaged in on-site learning at our Parishes, Chancery office, Catholic Charities, and local hospitals. Others are learning Spanish in Mexico. These experiences embody Pope Francis' call for a Church that listens, discerns, and serves all, most especially those who are vulnerable or poor.

We are blessed in the Archdiocese of Las Vegas to have so many Priests who give entirely of themselves in their ministry among our people. Their commitment to the parishioners, their fidelity to the Gospel, and devotion to the teachings of the Second Vatican Council make our Presbyterate second to none.
