THE HISTORY OF GUARDIAN ANGEL CATHEDRAL

magnificent windows, mosaics, murals, and architectural design, but also for its origin and history.

Its beginnings go back to 1958, when the Clerics of St. Viator began celebrating a 4:30 AM Sunday Mass at various hotels on the Strip to accommodate hotel/casino workers and visitors. The present church became a reality in 1963 as the Guardian Angel Shrine. When the Diocese of Reno became the Diocese of Reno-Las Vegas in 1977, the Shrine was designated as the Co-Cathedral of the Catholic Church in Nevada.

Guardian Angel Cathedral is unique not only for its In 1988, Guardian Angel Cathedral received an indult, a special permission from Rome, for a 2:30 PM Saturday anticipated Mass. In 1995, the Diocese of Las Vegas was established with Guardian Angel as the Cathedral of the Diocese.

> In 2023, Pope Francis elevated the Diocese of Las Vegas to a Metropolitan See, the Archdiocese of Las Vegas, and named Archbishop George Leo Thomas, Ph.D. its first archbishop.


